

Subject: Cell Phone usage you didn't know about!

4 Things you might not have known about your Cell Phone.

For everyone with a cell phone. This should be printed and kept in your car, purse, & wallet. Good information to have with you at *ALL* times.

There are a few things that can be done in times of grave emergencies.

Your mobile phone can actually be a life saver or an emergency tool for survival.

·Check out the 4 things you can do with it:

FIRST (Emergency)

The Emergency Number worldwide for Mobile phones is **112** if you find yourself out of area of your mobile network and there is an Emergency, dial **112** and the mobile will search any

existing network to establish the emergency number for you, and interestingly, this number can be dialed even if the keypad is locked. Try it...it works!

SECOND (Hidden Battery Power)

Imagine your cell battery is very low. To activate, press the keys ***3370#** Your cell phone will then

re-start with this reserve, and the phone will now show a 50% increase in battery life.

This reserve will get charged when you re-charge your cell phone the next time.

THIRD (How to disable a *STOLEN* mobile phone)

To check your Mobile phone's serial number, key in the following digits on your phone, it is: ***#06# Record your 15 digit number here: _____.**

A 15-digit code will appear on the screen. This number is unique to your handset only.

Write it down and keep it somewhere safe...record your number above now!

If your phone is stolen, you need to call your service provider (AT&T, Verizon, or Sprint) and give them this unique 15 digit code.

They can then block and deactivate your phone. Even if the thief changes the *SIM* card, your phone will now be *totally useless*.

You probably won't get your phone back, but at least you know that whomever stole it can't use it **OR** sell it either. If everybody does this, there would be no point in people stealing cell phones.

FOURTH (Free Directory Service for Cells)

Cell phone companies are charging us \$1.00 to \$1.75 or more for 411 information calls when they don't have to.

Most of us do not carry a telephone directory in our vehicle, which makes these situations even more of a problem. When you need to use the 411 information option, simply dial:

(800) FREE4H or (800) 373-3411

without incurring any charge at all. Program this into your cell phone now.
